



Floridians Against REAL ID has written two bills for the 2012 Florida Legislative Session. One deals with your driver's license, and the other with your rights and procedures in traffic court.

The first bill restores common sense to our licensing procedure. As many have found out, it is very difficult to renew your driver's license now. What many do not know is we've spent over \$10 million on this idea and it has failed to do what it set out to do- rid us of illegal immigrants and terrorists. It has hurt the average citizens of Florida, especially women- due to name changes. About half the states have rejected this law.

The second bill establishes certain rights and procedures in traffic court when automated devices are used. Notably, you have the rights against self-incrimination and to have all witnesses present in court. It also establishes a system of accuracy checks for these devices similar to what police do for radars.

**Your help is needed!** What we need are people throughout the state to meet with their elected officials over the summer and ask them to sponsor this legislation. You don't need to be a professional speaker, just a citizen that wishes to have your rights restored and protected. You need less than 15 minutes of your elected official's time.
